You will be responsible for ensuring that the students assigned to you are present at each check-in point. The number of students assigned to each chaperone will depend on the number of chaperones on the trip.
- 2. You will be responsible for helping any student in your group deal with Guest Services when a Park Hopper ticket is loss.
- 3. Notify the band director if you have any reason to believe that any student is not eating due to lack of money.
- 4. Notify the band director if you have any reason to believe there has been any infraction of the Behavior Contract or Student Rules by any student.
- 5. Notify the band director is you have any safety concerns.
- 6. Notify the band director if one of the students is ill.
- 7. Review the trip itinerary and Student Rules. Upon arrival at the hotel, you will meet your assigned students and review the itinerary and Student Rules with them before allowing them access to their rooms.
- 8. Keep a copy of your student list and itinerary in your possession at all times.
- 9. Conduct a room check and bed check of your assigned rooms at night at curfew time.
- 10. At check out time, check each of your assigned rooms for cleanliness and damages.

 Report damages to the band director. Have your students clean the room if necessary (ie trash should be in the garbage containers!)
